conclusion of the agreement. The power of attorney shall be signed by all Economic Operators. All and any correspondence and settlements will be made exclusively with the attorney nominated by the Economic Operators.

4. The offer of **Economic Operators** applying jointly for the contract, shall be signed on their behalf by an attorney nominated by them.
5. In case an offer submitted by Economic Operators jointly applying for the contract shall be selected, prior to conclusion of such contract, **Contracting Entity** shall be presented with an agreement regulating the cooperation of Economic Operators jointly applying for the award of a public contract.

XIII.2.1) Personal situation of economic operators, including requirements relating to enrolment on professional or trade registers:

Information and formalities necessary for evaluating if the requirements are met:

1. The Contracting Authority shall exclude Economic Operators from the contract award procedure on the basis of Article 24 para 1 of the PPL.
2. The Contracting Authority shall exclude from the contract award procedure Economic Operators referred to in Article 24 para. 5 (1) of the PPL.
3. An Economic Operator subject to exclusion on the basis of Article 24 para. 1 (13) and 1 (14) as well as para 1 (16) to para 1 (20), or para. 5 of the PPL, may present evidence that measures undertaken by them are sufficient to demonstrate their reliability, and in particular to evidence that the damage inflicted by a criminal offence or fiscal offence has been redressed, or that a compensation for non-material damage has been paid or the damage was redressed, with exhaustive description of the factual state and cooperation with the law enforcement authorities, as well as undertaking specific technical, organisational, and staff measures to prevent further criminal offences, fiscal offences, or irregular activities of the Economic Operator. The provision of the first sentence shall not apply if with regard to an Economic Operator that is a collective entity a prohibition from applying for a contract has been imposed by a final verdict, and the period of validity of this prohibition, defined in the verdict, has not lapsed.
4. An Economic Operator shall not be subject to exclusion, if the Contracting Authority, taking account of the significance and specific circumstances of Economic Operator's act, deems the evidence presented pursuant to point 3 above to be sufficient.
5. In cases referred to in Article 24 para. 1 (19) of the PPL, before excluding an Economic Operator the Contracting Authority shall ensure to that operator a possibility of demonstrating that their participation in the preparation of the contract award procedure will not distort competition. The Contracting Authority shall specify in the protocol the manner in which competition will be ensured.
6. The offer prepared on the basis of the Offer Form, which constitutes Appendix 1 to the Specification of Essential Terms of the Contract (**SIWZ**) should include current declaration submitted in the form of ESPD and the documents referred to in paragraphs 7 and 8 below, section III.1.3) point. 3 of the Notice and point 5.3. of SIWZ, valid at the time of offer submission. Other documents the Economic Operator shall submit upon the call of the Contracting Authority.
7. An Economic Operator, who relies on the resources of other entities, in order to demonstrate the absence of the existence of grounds for exclusion against them and to meet, to the extent to which he refers to their resources, conditions of participation in the proceedings, is obliged to submit the ESPD's of these entities together with the offer.
8. An Economic Operator, who intends to entrust the execution of part(s) of the order to subcontractors, in order to demonstrate the lack of existence of the grounds for exclusion

from participation in the contract award procedure towards his subcontractors shall also submit the ESPDs relating to these subcontractors together with the offer.

9. An ESPD should be drawn up in accordance with the standard form set out in the Executive Regulation of the European Commission issued pursuant to Art. 59 paragraph. 20 2 of the Directive 14/24/EU and Article. 80 para 3 of the Directive 2014/25/EU.

11. If necessary for ensuring the correct course of a contract award procedure, the Contracting Authority may, at each stage of the procedure, call on the Economic Operators to submit all or some of the declarations or documents confirming that they are not subject to exclusion, comply with the conditions for participation in the procedure or with the selection criteria, and if there are justified grounds for regarding the declarations or documents submitted earlier as no longer valid, to submit valid declarations or documents..
12. If an Economic Operator failed to submit the declaration referred to in Article 25a para. 1 of the PPL, the declarations or documents confirming the circumstances referred to in Article 25 para. 1 of the PPL, or other documents necessary to carry out a procedure, the declarations or documents are incomplete, contain errors, or raise doubts specified by the Contracting Authority, the Contracting Authority shall request that they be submitted, supplemented, or corrected, or to explanations were provided within the time limit specified by the Contracting Authority, unless despite their submission, supplementation, or correction, or despite provide explanations, the tender of the Economic Operator would be rejected or if it would be necessary to cancel the procedure.
13. If an Economic Operator failed to submit the required powers of attorney or submitted defective powers of attorney, the Contracting Authority shall call on the Economic Operator to submit them within the time limit specified by the Contracting Authority, unless despite their submission, the Economic Operator's tender would be rejected or if it would be necessary to cancel the procedure.
14. The Contracting Authority shall fix a time limit for explanations referring to documents and declarations, referred to in Article 25 para. 1 of the PPL.
15. An Economic Operator is not obliged to submit declarations or documents confirming the circumstances referred to in Article 25 para. 1 (1) and (3) of the PPL, if the Contracting Authority holds declarations or documents concerning the Economic Operator or can obtain them through free-of-charge and generally accessible data bases, and in particular public registers within the meaning of the Act of 17 February 2005 on the computerisation of activities carrying out public tasks (Journal of Laws of 2014, item 1114; and of 2016, item 352).
16. Subject to Article. 133 para. 4 of the PPL, the Contractor is not excluded in the case referred to in Article. 24 para. 1 (13) (d) of the PPL, and in the case referred to in Article. 24 para. 1 (14) of the PPL, if the person referred to in that provision has been convicted of an offense listed in Article. 24 para. 1 (13) (d) of the PPL
 - 3) current certificate of the head of the competent tax office confirming that the economic operator is not in arrears with the payment of taxes or certificate stating that the economic

- 4) current certificates of the relevant branch of the Social Insurance Institution (ZUS) or Agricultural Social Insurance Fund (KRUS) confirming that the economic operator is not in arrears with the payment of social health insurance premiums or confirmation that the economic operator was legally entitled to exemption, deferment or spread of outstanding payment into installments or stating that the execution of a decision of a competent authority has been stopped in its entirety – issued not earlier than 3 months prior to the expiry of the time limit for submission of the offers,
- 5) current excerpt from relevant register or business activity central register and information record, if separate legal provisions require an entry in the register or record in order to show lack of grounds for exclusion under art. 24 para. 5 (1) of the PPL,
- 6) a statement of the Economic Operator about the lack of issue to him a final judgment or final administrative decision of the arrears of payment of taxes, fees or premiums for social or medical insurance, or - in the event of such a judgment or decision - documents proving the payment of these receivables together with any interest or fines or a binding agreement on the repayment of such debts,

17. Economic Operators jointly applying for the contract are obliged to submit a document appointing a proxy authorized to represent them in the proceedings or to represent them in the proceedings and conclude the contract.
18. Contracting Authority requires that an Economic Operator, which relies on abilities or situation of other entities under the terms of Article 22a of the PPL, provides the documents referred to in section 16 points. 2-8) above with respect to these entities.
19. 24. Credentials of the documents certified as a "true copy" shall be done by Economic Operator, entity, on abilities or situation of which an Economic Operator relies on, Economic Operators jointly applying for a public contract or subcontractor, in terms of documents that relate to each of them.
25. Certification of compliance with the original shall be in writing or in electronic form.
26. The Contracting Authority may request submission of original or notarized copies of documents other than the statements, only when submitted copy of the document is illegible or raises doubts as to its authenticity.

Situation when the a/m conditions are not met by an Economic Operator shall formal grounds to exclusion of an Economic Operator from the contract award procedure, with the reservation of Article 24 para 3 of the PPL
3. An Economic Operator may, in order to confirm the fulfillment of conditions for participation in the contact award procedure to rely on the capacities of technical or professional or financial situation of other economic entities, regardless of the legal nature of the legal relationship with them.
4. An Economic Operator who relies on abilities or situation of other entities, must prove to the Contracting Authority that at the time of order performance, he will have the necessary resources of these entities, in particular by presenting their obligations to provide him with the necessary resources for the execution of the order.
5. An Economic Operator who relies on abilities or situation of other entities, shall be jointly and severally liable with the entity who is committed to make the resources available, for the damage suffered by the Contracting Authority arising as a result of withholding the resources, unless the withholding of resources is not at his fault.
6. The Contracting Authority will assess whether technical or vocational capabilities or financial situation or economic standing made available to the Contractor by other entities allow to demonstrate that Economic Operator meets the conditions for participation in the contract award procedure and examine whether there are grounds for exclusion of such entity referred to in Article. 24 para. 1 (13)-(22) and para 5 (1) of the PPL.
7. Contracting Authority may, at any stage of the proceedings, consider that an Economic Operator does not have the required capacity, if the involvement of technical or professional resources of the Economic Operator in his other business ventures may have a negative impact on the implementation of the order.
8. In order to confirm the fulfillment of conditions for participation in the contract award procedure

described in point. 1 above, an Economic Operator shall submit

- 1) Economic Operator's declaration of annual turnover of the Economic Operator in the area covered by the contract, in the last 3 (three) financial years, and if the activity period is shorter - in this period,
9. In the event that Economic Operator in order to confirm eligibility for participation in the proceedings will provide together with the tender statements or documents in which the amount indicated will be given in a currency other than PLN, the Contracting Authority in order to assess compliance with the requirements set as conditions to participate in the contract award procedure will convert the amounts into PLN according to the average exchange rate of Polish National Bank (NBP) issued on the date of the offer submission deadline. Should the exchange rate effective on that date was unavailable, Contracting Authority will convert the appropriate amount according to the last available rate published before the deadline for submission of the offers.

The similar parameters shall be understood as pipeline diameter from 4" to 5" OD and the steel grade between X-56C to X-65C.
 - b) in case of Task 2: in the last 5 years prior to the offer submission deadline (if the period of activity is shorter - in this period) have carried out at least 50 connections with the use of the ZAP-LOK technology ZAP-LOK of subsea coiled CTP pipeline made in technology and parameters similar to the ones described in Appendix 1 to the SIWZ, in particular, in terms of a dedicated type of steel, mechanical and geometrical parameters of the pipeline referred to in the a/m Appendix. The similar parameters shall be understood as pipeline diameter from 4" to 5" OD and the steel grade between X-56C to X-65C.;
 - 2) personnel with appropriate qualifications and experience, i.e. experience in:
 - a) in case of Task 1: installation of pipelines made in technology and parameters described in Appendix No. 1 to SIWZ, i.e. have at their disposal a minimum of 10 persons with a minimum of 5 years' experience in the installation of subsea pipelines, who will participate in the performance of the contract
 - b) in case of Task 2: experience in connecting with the use of ZAP-LOK technology of sections of the pipeline made in technology and parameters described in Appendix 1 to SIWZ, i.e. have a minimum of 5 persons with a minimum of 5 years of experience in connecting of offshore pipelines in the ZAP-LOK technology, who will participate in the performance of the contract.
 - 3) regardless of the tasks which the Economic Operator's offer concerns: have equipment able to perform the work required by Contracting Authority and the basic technical facilities to provide services in a consistent manner in the period of time required by Contracting Authority.
2. The assessment of fulfillment of the above condition(s) will be made on the basis of an analysis of declarations and documents described in point 8 below. Situation when the a/m conditions are not met by an Economic Operator shall formal grounds to exclusion of an Economic Operator from the contract award procedure, with the reservation of Article 24 para 3 of the PPL

3. An Economic Operator may, in order to confirm the fulfillment of conditions for participation in the contact award procedure to rely on the capacities of technical or professional or financial situation of other economic entities, regardless of the legal nature of the legal relationship with them.
4. An Economic Operator who relies on abilities or situation of other entities, must prove to the Contracting Authority that at the time of order performance, he will have the necessary resources of these entities, in particular by presenting their obligations to provide him with the necessary resources for the execution of the order.
5.  - 1) within the scope of the condition set in point 1 (1), (2) and (3) above:
 - a) a list of services performed in the last 5 years prior to the deadline for offer submission and if the period of activity is shorter - in this period, with their value, the object, dates of execution and entities to whom the services were performed, and with attached evidence confirming whether these services have been performed properly, the evidence referred to are references or other documents issued by the entity to whom the services were performed, and if a valid reason of the objective nature of the Economic Operator is not able to obtain these documents - a statement of the Economic Operator,
